General Eligibility:

This award is provided to students pursuing a degree. It is specifically crafted towards assisting students who are most in need of funds to pay tuition, purchase books, and supplies.

Criteria:

If you are a High School Student;

1. The recipient must be:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be a graduating high school senior, who is a member of a Sigma Beta Club in their home city
- Have a high school cumulative GPA of 3.50 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
- Must have applied for and received admission to the college or university you plan to attend
- Classified as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior in good standing
- Demonstrated leadership and community service
- Submit an official transcript with the school seal and an authorized official’s signature
- Submit a completely executed and signed Sigma Scholarship application (original signature only)

If you are a College Student;

1. The recipient must be:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Currently admitted and attending an accredited college or university
- Currently holding at least a 3.50 GPA at the college or university, submitting with the application or official transcript
- Demonstrated leadership and community service
- Submit a completely executed and signed Sigma Scholarship application (original signature only)

2. Rules and Regulations:

1. All entries into this application must be true and acquired.
2. All copies of transcripts both high school and college must be the official, original documents, issues by the college and university with appropriate seal or watermark.
3. Once you have received any “Sigma Education Nation” award any instance of criminal activities will disqualify you from any future additional or continuing award.
4. High school awardee must contact the undergraduate chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. on the campus or university for which he has registered, to inform them of your enrollment at the college and university and provide for them your current address, telephone number and email address, whether housed on or off the campus.
5. All awardees must conduct themselves on the campus in a way which garners the respect of other students on the campus and all officials of the university.
6. Any change in your enrollment status or contact information must be reported to the local undergraduate chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.
